The final public event of the VALoR project was hosted by Speha Fresia and Italia Nostra, in Rome, Italy on Wednesday, 23rd October 2019.

At the final conference, project partners as well as members of festival committees and trainees from Italy who supported the project, were invited to speak and share their experience of the VALoR project.

With partners from rural areas in seven European countries, the final conference presentation highlighted the role of culture and tradition in boosting local economies and the importance of passing the 'know-how' from one generation to the next, especially when trying to preserve the cultural heritage of Europe through these local community festivals and events.

This conference also gave members of the VALoR project team the opportunity to showcase and officially launch the full range of education and mentoring resources that were developed by the project, and to encourage individual volunteers and whole communities to register on the online platform and start using the educational materials developed so that their cultural festivals and events can continue to be successful.


Our Plans for the Future!


